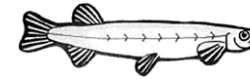

## What's in the book –

- information on the indigenous vegetation within the Harbour Basin clearly and simply presented
- a comprehensive guide to streamside planting and information about fish habitat



- a floral/food calendar - highlighting the flowering & fruiting times of plants and their role in the nurturing of native birds and lizards
- a “skite sites” feature identifying some significant natural features
- a panorama map of the area outlining the ecosystems
